COPE Food Pantry is **NOT** Closing!

Despite rumors to the contrary, the COPE Food Pantry will remain open as long as funding is available and volunteers come to help. The food pantry is exploring the prospect of becoming incorporated so it can continue serving the residents of this area.

There has been confusion recently about the fate of the food pantry. That confusion stems from the announcement the C.O.P.E., Inc. will be disband at the end of 2019. C.O.P.E., Inc. is the original organization that was established by the Covington Ministerial Association in 1983 in a attempt to avoid duplication of services in meeting the needs of the financially destressed in our area. Because of privacy laws, and the lack of a centralized screening agency, it has become extremely difficult to continue this ministry.

The COPE Food Pantry was born from C.O.P.E., Inc. to fulfill the need for emergency food that still exists today. This ministry regularly serves 300 to 400 families per month (an average of 700 to 800 individuals.) The food pantry is funded by donations and grants from local churches, industries, civic organizations, and individuals.

Please continue to support COPE Food Pantry through your prayer, contributions, and volunteering. Even the smallest effort is appreciated and can make a huge difference in the lives of your neighbors.



September 15th and October 20th will be our monthly COPE Food Collection Days. All types of non-perishable food is needed in the food pantry. Please help the food pantry remain well stocked for those in need.

We are grateful for all the donations of food and financial support provided by McAllister Church through the years and hope to continue this partnership for many years to come.


