A Word from the Pastor

What Does It Mean To Be A Reformed Church?

On Sunday, October 27, we celebrated our heritage as a Reformed church on what is known as Reformation Sunday. At our last Session meeting, we decided to include our church in an area -wide observance of this day. During our regular worship time, we hosted a special worship service and welcomed the good folks from First Presbyterian, Clifton Forge, Kayser Memorial, Falling Spring, Low Moor, and Mallow Presbyterian Churches.



The service was led by the ministers of all these churches, with Gary Marshall of Mallow preaching for us.

So what does being a Reformed church mean, anyway? And how does it fit into the larger spectrum of Christian churches? The following brief glossary of terms will help explain:

catholic (with a small "c") = All Christian churches of all types around the world.

Roman Catholic = What we know as Catholic (with a big "C"). They are the ones who follow the Pope in Rome.

Protestants = All the churches that broke away from the Roman Catholic Church back in the 1500's (including Presbyterians, Baptists, Methodists, Episcopalians, and many others)

Reformed = A specific group of Protestants based on the theology and practice of John Calvin. We believe in the sovereignty of God, a system of governance based on the election of elders, and the quality of being "Reformed, and always reforming."

Presbyterians = A specific group of Reformed Churches originally formed in Scotland.



Church Financial Books for 2019 will Close on December 30th


The Financial records for 2019 will close on Monday, December 30th. In order for contributions to be recorded in church records as 2019 gifts, they need to be received in the regular offering on December 29th, delivered to the office before 3:00 p.m. on Monday, December 30th, or made online by mid-night of December 31st.

The church office will be closed on Tuesday, December 31st, and Wednesday, January 1st so please do not bring contributions to the church on that day. Many thanks for all your financial gifts throughout the year and for your help as we work to close the books for 2019 in a timely manner.

The financial giving statements will be prepared as soon as possible <u>after</u> January 10th for pickup at the church. Please check the weekly bulletin for a more definite time. If you are unable to pick up your statement, please call the office to have it mailed to you.

Our Financial Records show that giving is down by more than \$63,500 from where we should have been by the end of September. It is extremely important to keep our finances healthy while we prepare to call a new minister. Please help this situation by being generous in your giving these last few weeks of 2019.

Christmas Cheer is Fast Approaching

The first knowledge of any Christmas outreach program at McAllister was in 1963 which involved the youth going door to door in the area around the church helping families at Christmas. Over time it changed into the program we now call Christmas Cheer. This is an outreach program of the church where families that need a helping hand are given food and presents so they will have a better Christmas. Church members turn in the names of families they know need some help and the rest of the families come from the Christmas Mother Program. At its height, close to 200 families were being helped each year. Funding for the Christmas Cheer program has always come from donations from our members above and beyond their normal tithes.

Over the last several years we have seen donations to this program decline and it has become harder to fund the program each year. We have had to reduce the number of families we help each year until we are now only helping about 50 families each year. Normally our Christmas Cheer fund this time of year has close to \$6000 in it, this year, we have less than \$2000. If we don't get more donations soon, we will not be able to continue our Christmas Cheer program as we nave known it. If you want to see this program continue, please make a designated donation to the Christmas Cheer Program.

Glove and Hat Tree


There will be a Christmas tree in the back of the church from November


