A Word From Your Pastor

It is hard to believe, but Lent is upon us! Lent is a time of preparation for the celebrations of Holy Week, when we feel the power of the crucifixion and the resurrection.

Lent is a time for spiritual discipline, which prompts many people to give up something for the season. Whether it's chocolate, or fast food, or something else – the giving up of something represents the ancient practice of fasting. I once knew a man who took this practice seriously, and gave up every other meal for the entire six-and-a-half week season.

In recent years, however, a new form of spiritual discipline has been growing in popularity among Christians. Instead of giving up something, they are taking on a new practice. This "taking on" can be a commitment to prayer or Bible reading, or perhaps volunteering with a charity – anything that involves an increase in a spiritual practice.

This year, I am going to take on the practice of prayer and meditation. I am going to find 15 minutes each day to slow down, and spend some time with God. My goal is to find relaxation and a time of reflection and quiet during the middle of each day. Too often we forget to do this simple practice that refreshes our minds and our spirits, and brings a little bit of Sabbath each day.




